New book is a definitive guide to teaching kids about money

Author and financial professional Kelley Keehn has published what appears to be the definitive book on how to teach your children about money.

The Prosperity Factor for Kids is the result of Keehn's belief that personal finance "is a subject that is either sadly under-represented or completely overlooked in the public education system."

Therefore, she says that the responsibility of ensuring children understand money concepts rests solely with parents.

"There's no need to worry if your experience with investments, finance, and money management are novice or non-existent; there's why you are reading this book," Keehns writes in the book's preface.

"If you're a seasoned investor and have a strong background in areas of finance, the material may be familiar to you; however, I think you'll find it's presented in a distinctive child-friendly format."

The book, which comes on the heels of Keehn's The Woman's Guide to Money, which was published last year, is a series of tools that go beyond merely explaining finances, but, rather, help the family identify and define its relationship with money and prosperity as a whole.
